Then he began to denounce the cities where most of his mighty works had been done, because they did not repent. "Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. <u>But I tell you, it will be more bearable on the day of judgment for Tyre and Sidon than for you</u>. And you, Capernaum, will you be exalted to heaven? You will be brought down to Hades. For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day. But <u>I tell you that it will be more tolerable on the day of judgment for the land of Sodom than for you.</u>" Matthew 11:20–24 (ESV)

## Judgment is based upon <u>works</u> done in this life.

And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. <u>And the dead were judged by what was</u> written in the books, according to what they had done... they were judged, each one of them, according to what they had done. Revelation 20:12–13 (ESV)

For <u>God will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret</u> <u>thing, whether good or evil</u>. Ecclesiastes 12:14 (ESV)



For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. John 3:17 (ESV)

# Those who do not believe in Jesus are still <u>condemned</u>.

Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but <u>whoever does not believe</u> is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the <u>only Son of God</u>. John 3:18 (ESV)

The Father loves the Son and has given all things into his hand. <u>Whoever</u> believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him. John 3:35–36 (ESV)

# According to God, we are <u>terminal</u> with the sickness of sin.

as it is written: "None is righteous, no, not one; no one understands; no one seeks for God. All have turned aside; together they have become worthless; no one does good, not even one." "Their throat is an open grave; they use their tongues to deceive." "The venom of asps is under Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but <u>whoever does not believe</u> is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the <u>only Son of God</u>. John 3:18 (ESV)

#### God is all about justice.

#### Hell isn't the same for everyone.

#### Judgment is based upon <u>light</u> received.

### What is condemnation for sin?

### Condemnation begins with <u>consequences</u> for sinful choices.

For this reason God gave them up to dishonorable passions. For their women exchanged natural relations for those that are contrary to nature; and the men likewise gave up natural relations with women and were consumed with passion for one another, men committing shameless acts with men and <u>receiving in themselves the due penalty for their error</u>. Romans 1:26–27 (ESV)

## Condemnation is completed by an eternity in <u>hell</u>.

### What is hell like?

#### Hell is described as a hideous garbage dump.

And if your hand causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter life crippled than with two hands to go to hell (Gehenna), to the unquenchable fire. Mark 9:43 (ESV)

#### Hell is described as a lake of fire.

Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire. Revelation 20:14–15 (ESV)

and the devil who had deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and sulfur where the beast and the false prophet were, and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever. Revelation 20:10 (ESV)

### What are distortions of hell?

#### Hell is not forever. - Annihilationism.
